Don't Bet on It! Intuition, Probability, and the CCSSM

Overview

Since the 1980s there has been an increased focus on probability in the school mathematics curriculum. Many probability ideas seem intuitive, yet our intuition often fails us. Indeed, probability is full of classic problems and paradoxes, and has been used to generate simple scams, fallacies, and ripoffs. This workshop will focus on probability concepts that are in the CCSSM. There will be a mix of interactive lectures aimed at content knowledge enhancement, and some hands-on activities that you can engage in during the workshop and then take into your classroom to use with your students.
