

## **ABSTRACT**

In the late 1960s Richard Thompson introduced three groups—F, T, and V—which have since played important roles as examples in group theory. For instance both T and V are examples of infinite simple groups. Still, many basic questions about these groups remain unresolved. This talk will focus on the smallest and best known of these groups, Thompson's group F.
