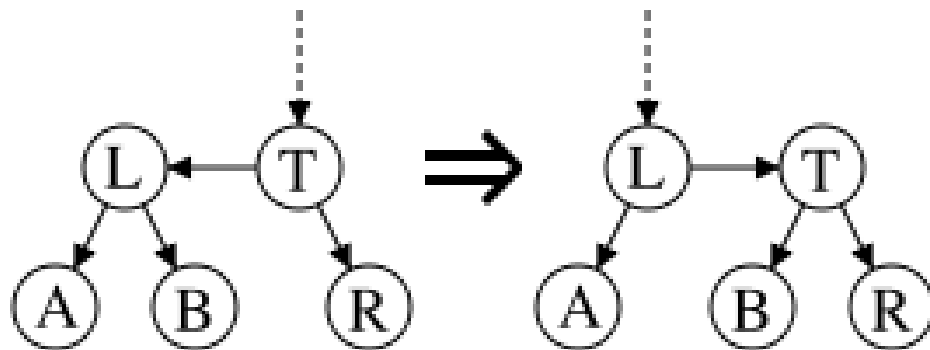

ABSTRACT

In the late 1960s Richard Thompson introduced three groups— F , T , and V —which have since played important roles as examples in group theory. For instance both T and V are examples of infinite simple groups. Still, many basic questions about these groups remain unresolved. This talk will focus on the smallest and best known of these groups, Thompson's group F .
