3 Corrections (mandatory)

1. If you earned a score of 89 points or more on Prelim 2, you do not need to rewrite any of your problems. You will receive full marks for this assignment.
2. If you earned less than 89 points on Prelim 2, then you must rewrite the two problems I circled.
3. First, give an explanation (in correct English!) of WHY you could not do each problem — “I forgot which formula to use”, “I got mixed up on the IVT”, “I was just completely confused and didnt understand the problem”, et cetera.
4. Second, write a solution to each problem as perfectly as you can — with all details and explanations, clearly showing your work. To receive full credit you must turn in your corrections with both questions correctly answered.
5. If a problem I circled has more than one part, you only need to correct those parts on which you lost credit.
6. This assignment will count towards your section grade.
7. In summary, for this assignment you must turn in...
 - your original Prelim 2;
 - a correct solution to each of the 2 problems I circled;
 - an explanation of your mistakes for each of the 2 problems I circled.
