Using WiFi as a Visitor to the Cornell Math Department

- Visitors from eduroam-participating institutions: Connect to the eduroam secure Wi-Fi network using your credentials from your home institution. You do not need to register as a guest or obtain Cornell credentials to use eduroam.
- Other visitors (without a NetID): Register to use the RedRover and Malott Wi-Fi networks at Cornell for up to 21 days per semester. See below for more information.

Connecting to RedRover

• Select the WiFi icon in your computer's tray or toolbar, and choose **RedRover** from the networks displayed. Then follow the registration procedure below.

Connecting to malottNxxxx

- Select the WiFi icon in your computer's tray or toolbar, and choose a network whose name starts with "malott" from the networks displayed. It is best to choose the one with the strongest signal.
- When it asks for a password, enter **oliverclub** (all one word, all lower-case). Then follow the registration procedure below.

Registration

- Once you are connected, open a web browser. You should see a registration page.
- Click on Others connect here.
- Fill out the form and click the **Register** button, then disconnect from the wireless, wait a few minutes, and reconnect. It can take up to 5 minutes for the registration to take effect.
